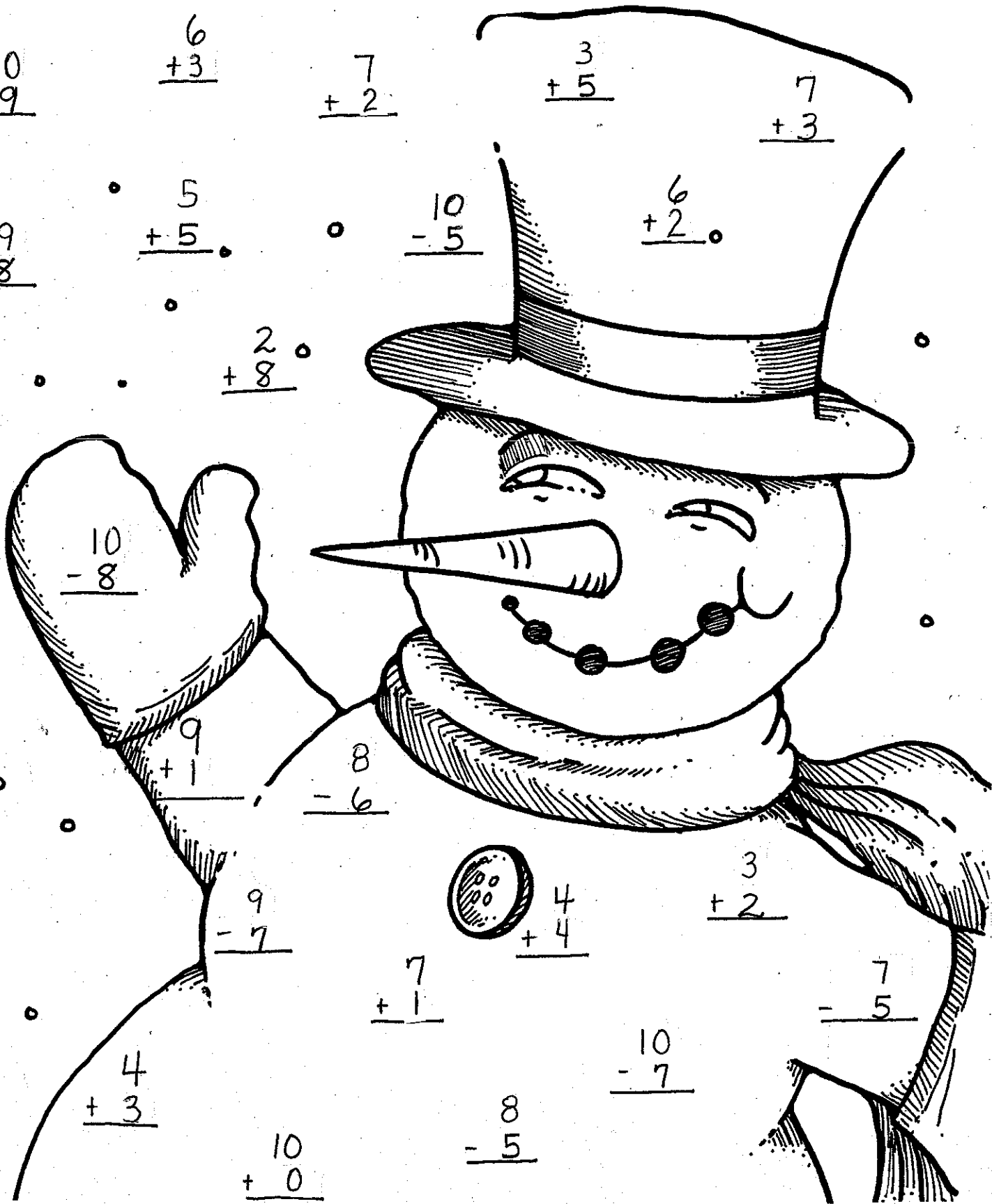

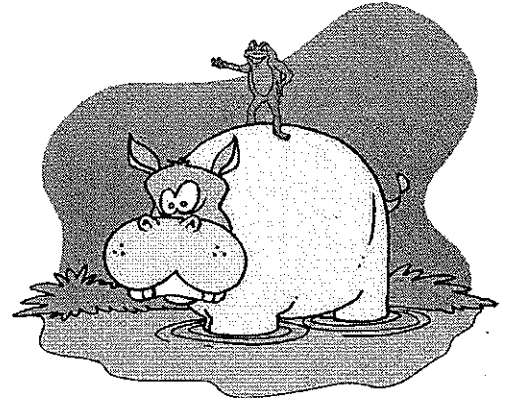

Frog said, "I like you Hippo, but I do not like bubbles in the water. It is loud when I swim."

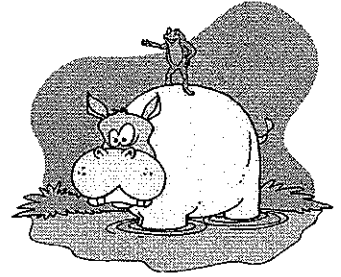
Hippo said, "I am sorry. I will not blow bubbles in the water."
